- LEGAL GUARDIAN / STUDENT NOTICE -

On December 14, 1987 the Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act (AHERA) became effective, requiring the district to inspect all buildings for friable and non-friable asbestos containing material and develop management plans which outline actions to be taken to control release of asbestos fibers.

All schools in the San Juan School District which we "lease, own, or otherwise use as a school building," have been inspected by accredited asbestos inspectors. As a result of this inspection we have compiled an Asbestos Management plan on every school. This plan identifies all asbestos containing material in the school building and our plans for dealing with it in the future.

The Asbestos Management plan for each school is available at the District Office (District Warehouse) and at each school for your viewing. A copy will be made, on request, for a nominal fee to cover the cost of copying and handling.

San Juan School District will continue to do inspections and six month surveillance for asbestos in the schools. For re-inspection the district has divided the schools into thirds. One third of the schools will be re-inspected each year. All of the schools will be surveyed every six months.

Asbestos removal projects have taken place in several buildings for renovation and remodeling. We will continue to manage and monitor all asbestos containing materials throughout the district thus helping us to maintain the standard of safety that is expected of this institution.

We will notify all concerned parties annually of the asbestos progress in the schools. A copy of this notification will also be sent to each school for posting.

We have taken every step possible to ensure a good program.
